The following services are available:

Internship/Job Search Assistance The office assists students in their internship/job search by conducting mock interviews, resume/cover letter critiques, and individualized meetings to create internship/job searching strategies.

Graduate/Professional School The office offers resources and individualized meetings to discuss graduate school programs, standardized tests, admission requirements, and timelines.

Career Advising and Counseling The professional Career Development staff meets individually with students to help them through self-exploration of interests, values, personality, and strengths, and the creation of a four-year career plan.

Programs A variety of programs are offered throughout the academic year. Topics often include career exploration, resume writing, interviewing skills, and networking, and alumni mentoring.

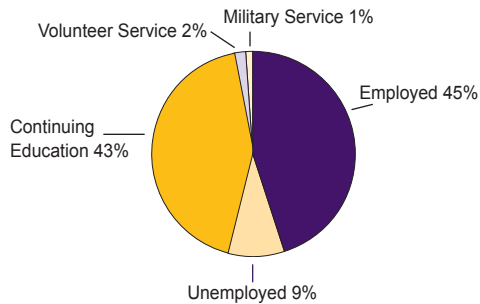

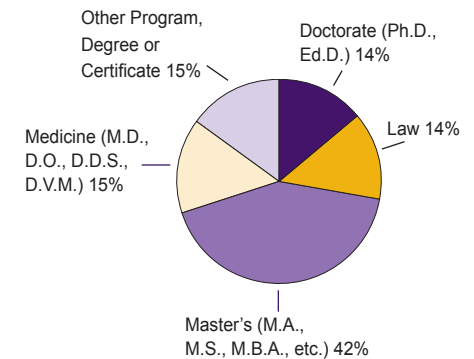
