CAMPUS SAFETY

Medical Emergencies include but are not limited to:

- Uncontrolled Bleeding
- Broken Bones
- Chest Pain
- Trouble Breathing
- Overdose
- Severe Burns

EXPRESS CARE ALBION

Students should utilize Express Care for non-emergency medical issues that require prompt attention. Walk-in care facility.

Medical non-emergencies include but are not limited to:

- Colds/Flu
- Sore Throat
- Ear or Eye Infections
- Sprains
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Minor Burns
- Wound Care
- Allergy Injections
- STD Tests
- Pregnancy Tests

FAMILY PRACTICE ALBION

Students should utilize Family Practice for non-emergency medical issues that may be scheduled. Appointment necessary facility.
